Basic Skills Professional Criteria

You will be considered by the Professionals Committee based on the need for your services and submission of a complete application. Applications will be reviewed by the Professional Committee before the recommendation is sent to the Board for a vote. The membership committee will notify you in writing or by phone of the Board's decision.

The 2015 deadline for Professionals renewing their membership is **June 12th, 2015**. If Professionals let their membership lapse beyond that time, they will need to reapply and once again go through the interview process.

Requirements:

Daily Basic Skills and Advanced Skills Coaches

- Five (5) years figure skating coaching experience
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- Professional Liability insurance listing Colonial Figure Skating Club, Inc. (CFSC), Nashoba Valley Olympia (NVO), and Olympus Realty Trust as additional insureds.

Sunday-Only Basic Skills Coaches

- Three (3) years figure skating coaching experience
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- Professional Liability insurance listing Colonial Figure Skating Club, Inc. (CFSC), Nashoba Valley Olympia (NVO), and Olympus Realty Trust as additional insureds.

Coaches teaching in the Basic Skills program will be required to sign a "Non compete" agreement, stating that any private coaching relationships attained through the Basic Skills program will only be continued at CFSC on CFSC ice.

Basic Skills-Only coaches (including Sunday-Only Basic Skills) may only teach on the red CFSC sessions, allowing non-member coaches and skaters to participate at a non-member rate, or on ice designated specifically as Basic Skills Practice Ice. Coaches are welcome to use red sessions if they would like to teach their skater more than the given practice time on Sunday mornings.
