



COLONIAL FIGURE SKATING CLUB, INC.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Colonial Figure Skating Club, Inc. (CFSC) Membership Season
July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017

Gold Level: \$450.00 (first family member); \$200.00 each additional family member. Includes 4 show tickets per family.

(10 Volunteer Hours or \$200 Assessment)

This membership confers unlimited pre-booking ice privileges and participation in all club activities at member rates. First parent membership is included with this membership. A second parent membership may be purchased for \$30. Gold memberships accrue full seniority (at a rate of 1 year for every year they are a member) when CFSC is designated as the member's Home Club. Voting privileges are granted if CFSC is designated as Home Club. Skaters who wish to represent CFSC at Regional, Sectional, or National competitions in Juvenile through Senior levels must have Gold memberships.

Silver Level: \$250.00 (first family member); \$195.00 each additional family member.

(5 Volunteer Hours or \$100 Assessment)

This membership is designed for skaters looking to pre-book a limited number of ice sessions. Confers walk-on ice reservation privileges and participation in club activities at member rates, but with **limited pre-booking privileges of up to 6 sessions per week** at the appropriate skating level. Voting privileges are granted if CFSC is designated as the Home Club. **First parent memberships must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18.** Skaters at this level who wish to represent CFSC are limited to standard track non-qualifying competitions and/or Adult qualifying and non-qualifying competitions. Silver memberships do not accrue seniority.

Bronze Level: Bronze Level Membership Fee: \$125.00 (first family member); \$100.00 each additional family member.

(3 Volunteer Hours or \$50 Assessment)

This membership designed to encourage Basic Skills and No Test skaters to become competitive skaters. Bronze membership allows a skater to pre-book up to 2 sessions per week on No Test ice. Bronze level members may additionally book Basic Skills practice ice, giving them more than 2 sessions per week. Bronze level members may participate in the Ice Crystals show. The Bronze Level Membership is only for low level skaters. Team skaters are not allowed under this membership. Once a skater has passed their Pre-Preliminary FS test, they must move up to the Silver Level Membership. **First parent memberships must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18.** There are no voting privileges conferred with this membership. Bronze skaters may represent CFSC competing in Basic Skills and No Test competitions. Bronze memberships do not accrue seniority.

Non-Resident Membership: **NEW: \$125.00**

This membership is available to skaters who have passed Juvenile Freestyle and above and are competing in a Regional, Sectional, or National Competition, **representing Colonial Figure Skating Club.** Eligible skaters must have no home, place of study, or place of business within a one hundred (100) mile radius of Colonial FSC, Boxborough, MA. Non-Resident Members are eligible for Colonial Competitors Jacket, skate in Sendoff Exhibitions and Annual Ice Crystals Show (abiding by Show Rules as outlined on application). Non-Resident Members can participate in club activities at member rates but **cannot pre-book ice** or vote at CFSC membership meetings. Non-Resident Memberships do not accrue seniority. **This membership will NOT be prorated. First parent memberships are required for skaters under the age of 18** but may be purchased through CFSC or another club.

Collegiate Membership: \$115.00 (includes four (4) consecutive years).

(No Volunteer Requirement)

This is a four-year membership at a reduced rate for college-aged members, and all skating privileges apply for the four-year duration. Each athlete may receive this option only once during their entire skating career. Collegiate memberships are for skaters 18 years of age or older who wish to maintain U.S. Figure Skating (USFS) and CFSC membership, but are no longer skating full time. Collegiate members can participate in club activities at member rates but cannot reserve ice or vote at CFSC membership meetings. Collegiate members will not accrue seniority.

Parent Membership: \$30.00

(No Additional Volunteer Requirement)

***One (1) parent of each skater under 18 years old who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club but hold a Membership type other than Gold, MUST purchase a Parent Membership.**

One (1) parent membership is required for every member under the age of 18, unless otherwise included in your membership level. Additional parent memberships may also be purchased. Parent memberships confer voting rights when CFSC is designated as the Home Club and participation in all club activities at member rates.

Team: \$200.00

(5 Volunteer Hours or \$100 Assessment)

The Team Membership is designed for skaters who participate in CFSC's Synchronized Skating or Theatre on Ice teams. The Team Membership category allows skaters to skate on team practice ice, confers ***pre-booking ice privileges of up to 3 sessions per week at the appropriate level***, and participation in club activities at member rates. *Team memberships do not accrue seniority. First parent memberships must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18.* Those who designate CFSC as their home club receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

Associate: \$115.00

(No Volunteer Requirement)

Associate memberships are for skaters 18 years of age or older who wish to maintain USFS and CFSC memberships, but are no longer skating full time. Associate members can participate in club activities at member rates but ***cannot pre-book ice*** or vote at CFSC membership meetings. *Associate members do not accrue seniority.*

Special Memberships

Honorary: N/C

(No Volunteer Requirement)

This membership is a lifetime membership confirmed by a vote of the membership at an annual meeting upon recommendation of the Board of Directors. This special membership is awarded to a selected member honoring his or her contribution to CFSC. The membership is free and includes the right to participate in all club activities at member rates. This membership does not include ice reservation. Honorary members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

Officials: N/C

(No Volunteer Requirement)

Official memberships are provided to USFS appointed officials who are eligible for inclusion in the Officials Directory of the USFS Rulebook and designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club. These members do not accrue seniority, may participate in club activities at member rates. Official members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

Professional Memberships

Full Professional: \$320.00 Children of Professionals: \$200.00

(5 Volunteer Hours or \$100.00 Assessment)

Full Professional memberships are required annually for all Board-approved eligible and ineligible professionals affiliated with and/or using club facilities and/or contracted ice for teaching purposes. Professional members may participate in club activities at member rates, but may not reserve ice. Professional members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

Basic Skills Professional: \$215.00

(5 Volunteer Hours or \$100.00 Assessment)

Basic Skills Professional memberships are required annually for all Board-approved eligible and ineligible professionals who are teaching in the Basic Skills Program only. Minimum of five (5) years teaching experience required. Professional involvement with any activity other than Basic Skills will require an upgraded membership classification. Basic Skills Professional members may participate in club activities at member rates, but may not reserve ice. Basic Skills Professional members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

Basic Skills Substitute: N/C for 'Substitute' memberships, unless the substitute is assigned a permanent class.

(No Volunteer Requirement)

Basic Skills Substitute memberships must meet the expectations listed for the Basic Skills Professional membership. Applicants must be approved by the Professional's Committee and are required to complete all necessary paperwork, in addition to submitting insurance certificates naming CFSC, NVO and Olympus Reality Trust. These members may only teach private students on the red CFSC sessions allowing non-member coaches and skaters to participate at a non-member rate. Coaches are welcome to use red sessions if they would like to teach their skater more than the given practice time on Sunday mornings.
