[CRITERIA FOR PROSPECTIVE OFF ICE COACHES]

There are three criteria that will be considered during the application review:

- CONTINUING EDUCATION
- PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIALS
- CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

You will need to satisfy **at least one bullet item from each criterion**. You will be considered for an interview with the Professionals Committee based on the need for your services and the submission of a complete application. The Committee's recommendation is made to the Board of Directors who usually meets the first Monday of each month. The membership committee will notify you in writing or by phone of the Board's decision.

Part I Continuing Education

Applicant must have completed at least one of the following and provide a copy of the certificate/affidavit.

Note: As is applicable.

Part II Professional Credentials

Applicant must be a Certified Strength & Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) through the National Strength and Conditioning Association as well as possess one of the following degrees. Provide a copy of the certificate/affidavit.

- Bachelor of Science degree in Physical Therapy and current Massachusetts board certified
- Bachelor of Science degree in Exercise Physiology from an accredited institution
- Bachelor of Science degree in Athletic Training from an accredited institution

Part III Clinical Experience

Applicant must have completed at least one of the following and provide a copy of the certificate/affidavit.

Physical Therapist

- 1 to 2 years of Orthopedic and Sports Medicine experience (preferably someone with a skating or dance background)
- Advance training or certification in Orthopedics or Sports Medicine
- Orthopedic Clinical Specialist
- Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Manual Physical Therapist
