[CRITERIA FOR PROSPECTIVE OFF ICE DANCE INSTRUCTORS]

There are six criteria that will be considered during the application review:

- TEACHING EXPERIENCE
- EXPERTISE IN SPECIFIC DANCE FORMS
- EXPERIENCE RELATING DANCE TO SKATING
- TEACHING DEGREE
- PERFORMING EXPERIENCE
- SCREENED BY A DANCE PROFESSIONAL

You will be considered for an interview with the Professionals Committee based on the need for your services and the submission of a complete application. The Committee's recommendation is made to the Board of Directors who usually meets the first Monday of each month. The membership committee will notify you in writing or by phone of the Board's decision. The following six criteria will be the bases of the final decision.

Part I Teaching Experience

Applicant must have:

- Five years teaching experience
- Two professional references
- Current resume

Part II Expertise in Specific Dance Forms

Applicant must have Ten years of training in:

- Ballet
- Jazz
- Modern
- Other

Part III. Experience Relating Dance to Skating

Applicant must have three to five years of experience in this field.

Part IV Teaching Degree

Applicant must have:

- Bachelor of Science degree
in: Education
Dance
Physical Education
- Bachelor of Arts degree in:
Education
Dance
Physical Education

Part V. Performing Experience

Applicant must have three to five years of experience

Part VI. Screen By A Dance Professional (Interview)

- A. Discuss teaching techniques.
- B. Discuss safe stretching and strengthening techniques.
- C. Discuss how to motivate and adapt to individuals.
